



## A Global Outreach Report

Every third Sunday throughout the year, we focus on a specific Missionary that Crossroads supports. Usually that is coupled with a request to keep each one of them in prayer as they continue to enlighten those in dark areas of the world with the good news of Jesus Christ.

Often, there is great news that is reported back to the Global Outreach Team and we thought that a summary of some of the comments might not only be of interest, but would be a benefit in helping you to pray for our Missionaries.

Due to both privacy and security issues and in many cases a request not to pass along specifics, the list below communicates the 'victories' that we see and read about.

But those 'victories', sometimes seemingly small, are very newsworthy as the listing below indicates.

### God is moving and He is moving in a powerful way.

- \* A pastor in the Congo in Africa writes that "Fourteen Pygmies affected by the recent flooding received Jesus Christ" as their Savior. DRC.
- \* "We saw our local church group commit to making 3 disciples each and planting 3 more churches by the coming August, 2020". North Africa.
- \* "Last year our Global Church Movements church planting teams in many countries planted 1,412 new small house churches and have planted more than 3,000 in the past three years". DRC.
- \* "I was thankful that God allowed our members of the Good News Club to regroup and try to effectively move forward as a team training new churches" - - - communicated while the public school system was on strike. USA.
- \* "In 2019 we estimate that 235,120 came to faith through our ministries in the countries of NAME". Africa
- \* "We have been able to be apart of 3 people coming to faith and getting baptized, and we have two more individuals who have expressed a desire to be baptized. One of them was formally being radicalized by ISIS to fight for Syria". Tunisia
- \* "This year (2019) we were able to be a part of multiple people coming to faith and getting baptized. We have others who are getting close". Africa.
- \* "The Lord is drawing many who have been betrayed, abused and abandoned. Whether young or old, God is restoring and redeeming these precious lives". Nepal.
- \* "Tabitha ministry (centers) are more than just sponsored girls taking literacy classes and learning job skills. Most importantly, they hear God's Truth and can find hope in Christ". Africa.
- \* Through your prayerful and financial support, "I am fully funded and it's been so sweet trusting God on this journey". USA

Our Missionaries are seeing unbelieving people become committed followers of Jesus Christ. Through your prayers, our hope is that you will also know the privilege of participating with Crossroads supported missionaries in the work of the Gospel. Thank you for continuing to pray for them.
