The fifth wall, constructed in marriages, creating barriers to intimacy and deeper relationships, is the **Wall of Humor**.

"Humor is a great trait to have and sometimes using it to relieve the tension of a hard situation can be beneficial. But using humor and sarcasm as a *replacement* for dealing with important conversations will end up building a wall between you and your spouse, keeping you at a distance emotionally rather than giving you the opportunity to connect deeply."

Do jokes come more readily than dealing with hard issues, sharing honestly, or talking through differences? Avoid the type of humor that shuts out your spouse, obstructs meaningful dialogue, and builds walls.

Crossroads Annual Congregational Meeting

November 10, 2019 @ 4:00 pm in the Station Room

In preparation for our Annual Congregational Meeting, here are some important items for you to know. Please remember, everyone is invited and welcome to attend this, however, only formal members are able to vote on the proposals.

1. Elder Nominees

The Elders propose **Joel Schumacher** and **Greg Gerard** as Elders to begin serving a three-year term in January of 2020. You can hear Joel and Greg's testimonies at the Town Hall meetings and you will be able to ask questions. Any biblical concerns regarding either of these nominees can be addressed with a current serving Elder. The Elders will be seeking the affirmation of these candidates from the congregation at the annual meeting. Absentee ballots are accepted for Elder nominees. Also, in January 2020, Bob Read and James Stone will be stepping off the Elder Team after completing a three-year term.

2. 2020 Proposed Budget

A booklet outlining the proposed budget for 2020 is now available. A summary page as well as a breakdown for each department is included. The booklets are available at the TV Kiosk labeled "2020 Proposed Budget Booklets". Feel free to pick up a copy and take it with you for review. The Elders will be seeking approval of the 2020 budget from the congregation at the annual meeting. Absentee ballots are <u>not</u> accepted for the budget proposal.

3. Proposed change to our Statement of Faith

This past June at the EFCA One Conference, 79% of the delegates present approved an amendment to Article 9 of the EFCA Statement of Faith (SOF) to read – "We believe in the personal, bodily and premillennial glorious return of our Lord Jesus Christ. The coming of Christ, at a time known only to God, demands constant expectancy and, as our blessed hope, motivates the believer to godly living, sacrificial service and energetic mission." Each local EFC has been invited to consider updating their SOF to reflect this change. The pastors/elders of Crossroads have reviewed the biblical/theological basis for this change and recommend that we adopt this change to our Crossroads SOF as per our Constitution. Additional information on the change to the EFCA SOF is available on the resource tables at the back of the Worship Center

4. Town Hall Meetings

There are two Town Hall meetings prior to the Congregational Meeting available for discussion regarding any of these items. The dates are **Wednesday, October 30** at **7:00pm** and **Sunday, November 3 at 11:15am**. Both meetings will be held at the Plymouth campus in **Room 105/07**.

5. Appointed Ministry Team Leaders for 2020

Our Ministry Team Leaders are gifted volunteer leaders in our ministry. They lead various teams to carry out the area of their focus, in effort to accomplish our overall vision of *being disciples who make disciples*. These positions are appointed by the Elders and not affirmed by the congregation. However, we ask the congregation if there are any biblical concerns regarding these leaders.
