A HUGE thank you to everyone who participated with Operation Christmas Child at Crossroads! Our goal for 2019 was to pack 500 shoe boxes. Because of your generosity, Crossroads packed 577 shoe boxes! That's 577 children who will hear about Jesus Christ! As a church, we raised over \$3,000.00 which was given to Samaritan's Ministries to help pay for shoe boxes to be shipped around the world! We are blown away by your generosity! Thank you!

We also wanted to share with you that, as a regional Collection Center, we collected a total of 1,636 shoe boxes in one week! We had 90 volunteers from Crossroads help during Collection Week and those volunteers served 281 hours! We can't begin to express our love and appreciation for the enthusiasm, support and generosity of our Crossroads family!

You all have played a vital role in helping take the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the ends of the earth! Please continue to pray for those that will receive a shoe box as well as for the local Pastors and volunteers who will have an opportunity to share The Greatest Journey story with these children.


