It is always with keen anticipation and then delight to have Missionaries come and grace Crossroads with their presence. This Sunday is no exception. We welcome Tibor Miklos today who has not only an enormous but passionate mission to reach thousands of people throughout Eastern Europe with the Gospel of Jesus Christ through audio Bibles.

Blind himself, Tibor lost his sight as a teenager, but through a series of God ordained events, he will tell you that 'God opened his spiritual eyes'. Because of that, he realized that God's desire for his life was to let the name of Jesus be glorified through his blindness.

Today, Tibor's ministry throughout Hungary and various other parts of Eastern Europe spreads the 'Good News" of Christ Jesus. His ministry is vibrant, it is growing and his sense of calling is being fulfilled. Whether it is giving out audio Bibles to blind and illiterate people in the city of Szekelyudvarhely, conducting a conference in Lake Balaton, Hungary or doing an outreach to the Hungarian Blind Association in Budapest, Tibor does so with joy and exultation. Through he and his wife, Marta, God is opening more and more doors for this ministry and there is great evidence of lives being transformed because of it. 
