IMPORTANT COMMUNITY GROUP INFORMATION FOR YOU

Unfortunately, we need to let everyone know that we will be cancelling our March 7th GroupLink Event.

You obviously have some questions. Keep reading to find out why we won't be offering GroupLink in March...

Why Are You Cancelling GroupLink? We simply don't have the leaders to start any new Community Groups.

Why Aren't There Any New Community Group Leaders? Some Community Group leaders continue to lead new groups after their previous groups end. Other group leaders take a break from leading for a while. We value giving our group leaders the ability to take a break. Group leaders on break are invited to return to start a new group every 6 months. Some leaders choose to return to start a new group while others find other areas of ministry inside and outside of Crossroads to serve.

What About Finding and Developing New Community Group Leaders? We find that our best new Community Group Leaders are found and developed within existing groups. The goal of the group leaders are to identify and help apprentice potential leaders over the duration of the group. It's a great way to train up new leaders however, not every group will produce new Community Group leaders.

We place an extremely high value on who leads our Community Groups because they are essentially leading a small home "church". Each group is an extension of Crossroads Church.

Even though we're bummed, we wanted to let you that there are a few options for you to still get connected!

We're Introducing CONNECT GROUPS! Starting on Sunday, March 8th, Pastor Marc will be leading a three-month long group that will be similar to a Community Group.

Who Is The CONNECT GROUP For? This group is for those who signed up to attend the upcoming GroupLink Event as well as for those who are seeking a way to connect with others in a small group environment but are not already in a Community Group.

Tell Me More About The Details! The Connect Group will meet every Sunday morning during 2nd Service in Room 105 & 107. It will begin on March 8th and end on May 31st.

What Will The Group Do? The goal of the Connect Group is to emulate a Community Group but in a shorter time frame. We'll work to build relationships with one another, engage in conversation about a Bible study and its application to our daily lives. Finally, we'll take some time to pray for one another.

Do I Need Sign Up To Participate In The CONNECT GROUP? For planning purposes, we need for you to let us know if you want to participate. Therefore, please see Pastor Marc in the New Connection Area this morning to sign up!

Is There A Minimum / Maximum Number Of People In Order To Have The CONNECT GROUP? Yes, there is. In order to get the most out of the small group experience, we need to have a minimum of 10 people. The most we can have in the group is 25. Yes, that's a big group but our goal is to "connect" people!

What If The CONNECT GROUP Doesn't Work For Me? There are so many different ways to connect with others at Crossroads and we want to help you find the right place! You can start by connecting with those that you serve with! Did you know that we have over 20 different ministry teams? Consider finding a place to serve on a Sunday morning. Join a Target Group or attend a ministry event / Bible study through the Men's & Women's Ministries. Over 50 years old? Attend a Ps92 Event! Have a heart for missions? Consider helping with Operation Christmas Child or Love Reach Projects.
